



# TOP 10 Pet Travel Tips

- 1. PET ID COLLARS** These should have final destination info. For Canada/Mexico, bring official proof of rabies vaccination, not just a tag.
- 2. RECONSIDER?** Be honest about your pet's ability to travel; be open to a kennel if health is a concern.
- 3. TRIM NAILS** This avoids damage to new surroundings, and also to restrain more easily if necessary.
- 4. NO FLEAS, PLEASE** Bathe before trip to avoid infesting new spaces.
- 5. ON A LEASH** Obey all leash laws and always clean up after your pet.
- 6. SMELL OF HOME** Keep your pet's stress at bay with familiar scented items from home.
- 7. TEST DRIVE** Unfamiliar with car travel? Plan a quick trip to acclimate pet. Remember, cats should be in a crate to for driver and animal safety.
- 8. FIRST AID** Pack a pet first-aid kit, including phone numbers of your veterinarian and a 24-hour emergency veterinary hospital.
- 9. FOOD & WATER** Always have fresh water on hand, maintain balanced diet for your pet.
- 10. RELAX...** Plan extra time for impulse side trips. Vacation is supposed to be fun for you and your pet!
